

You will create your very own book jacket for the Jungle Book. You might say "What's a Book Jacket?" A book jacket usually gives us our first clue of what a book will explore. From a book jacket, we can often tell what genre of a book, the information the book will discuss, an even what other readers think about the book.

You will create a book jacket using the presentation or document program in your Google Education account. You will submit your book jacket through Google Education.
